MERIDIAN CITY HALL TO SERVE AS EARLY VOTING LOCATION

MERIDIAN – Beginning Monday, October 19 at 8:00 am, Meridian City Hall will serve as an early voting location for the November 3 election. This is the first time this service has been offered in the City and it will be available from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm, Monday through Friday until October 30, 2015.
