Meridian, ID – The City of Meridian will kick off the ninth season of its popular CableONE Movie Night in Meridian on Friday, June 5, in Settlers Park. Every Friday through August 28, free family-friendly movies will be shown in the park on a 30-foot inflatable screen starting at dusk.

All CableONE Movie Nights will be staffed by the Meridian Parks and Recreation Department, the Meridian Police Department, event security staff, and community volunteers.
