**TRAFFIC ALERT:  
MANHOLE CONSTRUCTION REQUIRES TEMPORARY  
CLOSURE OF A SECTION OF TEN MILE ROAD**

MERIDIAN – A portion of Ten Mile Road (north of I-84) between Pine Avenue and Franklin Road will be closed beginning Wednesday, August 24 through Monday, August 29. The purpose of this closure is to install a sewer manhole in the center of Ten Mile Road. This necessary work is part of the City of Meridian’s construction of a water treatment facility, which will meet the needs of our growing community and provide the best water service possible to area residents and businesses.

Safety is the primary reason for the full road closure – not only for the construction workers, but also for the traveling public. Traffic will be notified about the detour at Cherry Lane and re-routed at Pine Avenue and Franklin Road, however business access will be available to customers and employees.
