This free night of trunk or treating will take place at Meridian City Hall beginning at 6:00 pm and will conclude at 9:00 pm. Attendees are encouraged to bring at least one non-perishable food item to benefit the Meridian Food Bank kicking off their holiday food collection campaign.

The Village at Meridian is the presenting sponsor for this year's event which is being organized by the Meridian Mayor's Youth Advisory Council (MYAC). Attendees will have the opportunity to visit approximately 100 decorated trunks who will be handing out candy or child themed items from community schools, churches, non-profits, and businesses. The 'Golden Cauldron' will be awarded to the best decorated trunk.

"This event has quickly become a community favorite and I'm proud MYAC is committed to providing a fun, safe, family friendly evening for all to enjoy," said Meridian Mayor Tammy de Weerd. "Last year they collected over 2,700 pounds of food – making a difference to families in need as we prepare for the winter holidays."
