ROAD REPAIRS CONTINUE ON FRANKLIN ROAD FOLLOWING WATER MAIN BREAK

MERIDIAN – City of Meridian Water Crews have repaired the water main that broke late Thursday morning on Franklin Road, just west of the Franklin, Locust Grove intersection. Crews are still working to repair the road, which is expected to last through the Friday morning commute. Traffic has been diverted to one lane in each direction and drivers should expect delays or take an alternate route.

As a result of the water main break, some residents in the area may notice that their water is discolored.

“Due to the high flows caused by the line break, naturally occurring minerals were stirred up which can cause water discoloration,” said Dennis Teller, City of Meridian Water Superintendent.

Teller says the water is safe but if residents do notice discoloration they should refrain from washing white clothes and run cold water for 10-15 minutes until it clears.
